- 4. Apart from participating in the races or cheering on the side-line, I hope you had a chance to pass by our booth and get to know more about Hong Kong on various fronts today. As some of you might already be aware of, the hotel quarantine period for travellers entering Hong Kong has recently been substantially shortened to three days. Perhaps it is time to plan your trip to Hong Kong next year to join us at the Hong Kong International Dragon Boat Races!
